Acts 2:21-24 God's Eternal Plan

Introduction: God had a plan.

- I. God's Person Jesus the Nazarene (vv. 21-22)
 - A. Calling on the name of the Lord (v. 21)
 - 1. God's Plan of Creation (Genesis 1:1, 27-28; 2:15-17)
 - a) God gave man volition and a choice as the representative of humanity
 - b) Man has an obligation to worship God (Psalm 96:7-9; 97:1; Rom 3:23; 9:20-21)
 - c) What was man's response? (1 Cor 15:21-22)
 - 2. The Fall (Genesis 3)
 - a) Satan's sin (Isa 14:14)
 - b) Adam's sin (Gen 3:5-6; Rom 6:23)
 - c) But God had a plan (Gen 3:15)
 - B. "Men of Israel, listen to these words" (v. 22) Peter's proclamation at Pentecost
 - 1. Jesus the Nazarene (Luke 18:37; Acts 3:6; 4:10; 6:14; 10:38; 22:8; 26:9)
 - a) People were often identified by their father's name (Simon Barjona = "son of Jonah," Matt 16:17) or their place of residence (Simon of Cyrene, Luke 23:26).
 - b) While Jesus was born in Bethlehem, He was raised in Nazareth (Matt 2:1, 13-15).
 - (1) Nazareth was a small, out of the way town 55 miles north of Jerusalem that is not specifically mentioned by name in the O.T.
 - (2) Jesus the Nazarene was despised (Psalm 22:6; Isa 49:7; 53:3; Matt 2:23; John 1:45-46)
 - 2. Attested to you by God
 - a) By miracles, wonders, and signs to authenticate a messenger and his message (2 Cor 12:12)
 - b) God's plan *in these miracles* was to give undeniable evidence of Jesus' deity and authority (Isa 35:5-6; 61:1; Matt 11:4-5; Luke 4:18-19).
 - c) What was man's response? (Matt 12:10-15, 22-24)
- II. God's Predetermination The Crucifixion (v. 23)
 - A. God's sovereign plan predetermined with foreknowledge" (Eph 1:3-5; Titus 1:1-2)
 - B. Man's responsibility What was man's response? They put Him to death
 - 1. You nailed to a cross (Jews)
 - 2. By the hands of lawless men (Romans)
 - 3. Our sin (all humanity) 1 Pet 2:24-25
- III. God's Power The Resurrection (v. 24)
 - A. God raised Him up again (God's plan)
 - 1. "putting an end to the agony of death" (1 Cor 15:20-22, 54-57)
 - 2. "it was impossible for Him to be held in its power" (John 11:25; Rom 1:16; Heb 2:14)
 - B. What is your response?

Conclusion: Because He lives . . . I can worship Him through a pleasing life of obedience to God in Christ!
